TAKE NOTICE that a petition (the **Petition**) has been presented to the High Court of Ireland (the **Court**) seeking approval for a scheme for the transfer of part of the non-life insurance business carried on by the German branch of Zurich Insurance plc (**ZIP**), having its registered office at Zurich House, Ballsbridge Park, Dublin 4, Ireland to DARAG Deutsche Versicherungs- und Rückversicherungs-AG (**DARAG**), having its registered office at Hermannstrasse 15, 20095 Hamburg, Germany (the **Scheme**). The business which is proposed to transfer under the Scheme consists of a portfolio of certain professional indemnity policies underwritten by ZIP and issued to architects and engineers (the **Policies**).

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that a copy of this Notice, the Petition (incorporating the said Scheme) and the report of an Independent Actuary on the Scheme will be available for inspection by the policyholders and shareholders of ZIP and DARAG at their respective registered offices and at ZIP's German branch office at Platz der Einheit 2, 60327, Frankfurt am Main, Germany between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. local time on each working day from the date hereof until the date that the said Petition is to be heard by the Court (both dates inclusive). Copies of the said documents will also be made available for viewing on the following websites: www.zurich.de/transfer-aue-haftpflicht and www.darag-group.com/claims/zurich_scheme_documents. Any person who cannot access these websites can request copies of the documents to be posted to them, free of charge, by contacting ZIP in the manner set out at the end of this Notice.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the said Petition is to be heard by the Court at 11.00am on 16 June 2020 at the Four Courts in the city of Dublin, Ireland. Any person who wishes to be heard at the hearing of the Petition should send a notice of their intention to so appear, in writing, to A&L Goodbody Solicitors at 25-28 North Wall Quay, International Financial Services Centre, Dublin 1, Ireland (Ref: LM/ADA) to arrive no later than 5.00pm on 2 June 2020 indicating whether they support or object to the proposed transfer. Any person who wishes to make submissions at the Court hearing or rely on evidence should file an affidavit setting out those

submissions or the evidence on which they propose to rely with the Court and serve a copy of that affidavit on A&L Goodbody at the aforementioned address to arrive no later than 5pm on 2 June 2020.
